The purpose of the public hearing is to receive comments and hear discussion concerning the issuance by the Authority of its Multifamily Housing Revenue Bonds in one or more series, in an aggregate face amount of not to exceed \$17,500,000 (the "Bonds"). The proceeds of the Bonds will be loaned to SAH HS Holdings, LLC, a Florida limited liability company, or its permitted successors and assigns (the "Huron Sophia Owner") and SAH CV Holdings, LLC, a Florida limited liability company, or its permitted successors or assigns (the "Capri Villas Owner"), and used for the purpose of financing all or a portion of the costs related to (i) the acquisition and rehabilitation of an existing multifamily residential housing facility for persons or families of low, middle or moderate income located at 2800 Sophia Street, Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida 32254, consisting of approximately 72 units currently known as Huron Sophia Apartments (the "Huron Sophia Project"), and (ii) the acquisition and rehabilitation of an existing multifamily residen-tial housing facility for persons or families of low, middle or moderate income located at 4832 N.
