ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,355,761.90, ΑN INCLUDING \$1,043,000 FROM GENERAL FUND FUND BALANCE AND \$292,761.90 FROM WELLS CREEK, LLC, MATTAMY JACKSONVILLE LLC, AND KB JACKSONVILLE LLC, TO THE AUTHORIZED CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND TO PAY FOR CONSTRUCTION OF TRAFFIC SIGNALIZATION IMPROVEMENTS AT THE INTERSECTION OF PHILIPS HIGHWAY AND WELLS CREEK PARKWAY (THE "PROJECT"); APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER AN AMENDED AND RESTATED ESCROW AND TRAFFIC SIGNALIZATION PROJECT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND WELLS CREEK, LLC, MATTAMY JACKSONVILLE LLC, KB HOME JACKSONVILLE LLC AND WELLS CREEK PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC., PROVIDING THE TERMS, CONDITIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARTIES WITH RESPECT TO THE PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2022-2023 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$1,355,761.90, including \$1,043,000 from General Fund fund balance and \$292,761.90 from Wells Creek, LLC, Mattamy Jacksonville LLC, and KB Home Jacksonville LLC (collectively, the "Funding Entities"), for construction of traffic signalization improvements at the intersection of Philips Highway and Wells Creek Parkway (the "Project").

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for the Project. The Funding Entities have placed a total of \$457,761.90 in escrow for the Project. In accordance with the Amended and Restated Escrow and Traffic Signalization Project Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference, Wells Creek Property Owners Association, Inc. (the "POA"), will retain a design professional(s) to design, engineer and permit the Project at a cost not-to-exceed \$165,000. The POA will thereafter transfer all Project plans and specifications prepared by the design professional(s) to the City of Jacksonville. The City will be responsible for construction of the Project and will secure a qualified contractor through a competitive, sealed bid process. After the City's receipt of bids for the Project, the remainder of the escrow funds shall be transferred to the City in an amount that may exceed, but shall not be less than, \$292,761.90. Should the Funding Entities fail to transfer the full contribution

outlined above to the City, the City will not be obligated to proceed with the Project.

and Authorization to Execute the Section 3. Approval Amended and Restated Escrow and Traffic Signalization Project Agreement. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, that certain Amended and Restated Escrow and Traffic Signalization Project Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Wells Creek, LLC, Mattamy Jacksonville LLC, KB Home Jacksonville LLC and Wells Creek Property Owners Association, Inc. (the "Agreement"), in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit 2. The Agreement may include such additions, deletions and changes as may be reasonable, necessary and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the Mayor or her designee, with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the Agreement by the Mayor or her designee.

No modification of the Agreement may increase the financial obligations or the liability of the City and any such modification shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the Office of General Counsel. For the purposes of this Ordinance, "technical changes" is defined as those having no financial impact to the City and other non-substantive changes that do not substantively increase the duties and responsibilities of the City under the provisions of the Agreement.

Section 4. Oversight. The Department of Public Works shall oversee the Project described herein.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
