Bill Summary: The bill approves the closure, abandonment, and/or disclaiming an opened and improved portion of the Church Street right-of-way established in LaVilla Harts Map, located in Council District 7. The City and JEA will reserve all utilities and facilities easement over the closed portion of the right-of-way.

Background Information: The applicant, Volunteers of America of Florida, Inc, owns the property located at 716 West Church Street (R.E. # 074692-0010) and seeks to improve the security and overall aesthetics of the property. The applicant paid the \$2,091.00 application fee. The all utilities and facilities easement includes but is not limited to water, sewer, electric and drainage, to provide the City and JEA continued access for repair and maintenance. There were no objections from any City, State, or utility agency to this closure request. The closure is contingent on the execution and delivery of a hold harmless covenant.
