Bill Summary: This bill appoints Nicholas Harding to the Jacksonville Health Facilities Authority, filling a seat formerly held by Stephen A. Frick, Jr., for a first full term ending December 15, 2028.

Background Information: The Jacksonville Health Facilities Authority is authorized through Chapter 154, Pt. III, *Florida Statutes*. Pursuant to Chapter 490, *Ordinance Code*, the Jacksonville Health Facilities Authority is established to assist health facilities in the acquisition, construction, financing, and refinancing of projects. Section 490.106(a), *Ordinance Code*, provides that the 5 members of the board are appointed by the Council.

Mr. Harding holds a bachelor's degree from UNF and is working towards his law degree from Mitchell Hamline School of Law. He works for the Mosquito Control Division of the Neighborhoods Department. Mr. Harding resides in Duval County in council district 5.
