SALEM AMENDMENT

Council Member Salem offers the following amendment to File 2022-450:

- 1) Amend Section 602.413, Ordinance Code, which requires additional disclosure of Council Members who are employed by nonprofits, or their spouse and children, prior to submission of a grant application by the non-profit, to include that it also applies to Chapter 117 grants as well.

DIAMOND AMENDMENT

Council Member Diamond offers the following amendment to File 2022-450:

- (1) Includes NCSPHS Amendment
- (2) Amends **Section 117.112 (Reporting), Ordinance Code**, to:
 - Require the Grants Office to send a comprehensive report to Council 2 times a year on 10/1 and 4/1 of each year
 - All departments, boards and commissions subject to Chapter 117 which manage their own grants must submit to the Grants Office their reporting requirements by 9/1 and 3/1 for inclusion in such semi-annual report from the Grants Office to the Council
- (3) Amends **Section 117.109 (Central review of grant applications), Ordinance Code**, to:
 - Strike existing provision that allows for submission of grant applications without Mayor's Review
