8 OPERATIONS - OFFICE EQUIPMENT ACCOUNT TO PROVIDE  
9 FUNDING FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF SIX (6) COIN AND  
10 CURRENCY RECYCLING/VERIFICATION MACHINES, AS  
11 INITIATED BY B.T. 24-135; PROVIDING FOR  
12 CARRYOVER OF FUNDS INTO FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025;

16 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,  
17 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated

27 The funding above is an appropriation of funds from the  
28 Tax Collector Tax Redemption Fees - Tax Sale account to  
29 the Tax Collector General Operations - Office Equipment  
30 account to provide funding for the replacement of six (6)  
31 coin and currency recycling/verification machines at the

1 Tax Collector facilities.

2 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
3 Section 1 is to provide funding for the replacement of six (6) coin  
4 and currency recycling/verification machines used by the Duval County  
5 Tax Collector. The existing equipment has been used extensively on a  
6 daily basis for the past eight (8) years and needs replacement.

7 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in this  
8 Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year  
9 2024-2025.

10 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
11 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
12 without the Mayor's signature.
