ORDINANCE 2020-492-E AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE TO PROVIDE DIRECT FUNDING IN THE OF \$200,640.00 FOR COMMUNITIES AMOUNT ΙN INC. SCHOOLS OF JACKSONVILLE, ("CIS") TO PROVIDE CHILDREN'S SERVICES IN AN AFTERSCHOOL AND SUMMER PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE TO CONTRACT DIRECTLY WITH CIS PROVIDE AFTERSCHOOL AND SUMMER PROGRAMMING AT CARTER G. WOODSON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL FOR THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR AND THE IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING SUMMER; AMENDING 2019-511-E SECOND REVISED SCHEDULE M TO INCLUDE COMMUNITY IN SCHOOLS OF JACKSONVILLE, INC.; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION TO SECTION 126.107(G) (EXEMPTIONS), (GENERAL REGULATIONS), CHAPTER (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, REGARDING CHILDREN'S SERVICES PROGRAMMING PROVIDED BY CIS AS SPECIFIED ΙN THIS ORDINANCE; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY, AND/OR THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A CHILDREN'S SERVICES CONTRACT WITH CIS; WAIVING THE

ALLIANCE), SECTION 77.111(a) (PROVIDER CONTRACTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO EXEMPT THE CHILDREN'S SERVICES PROGRAMMING TO BE PROVIDED BY CIS FROM COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Background. Communities in Schools of Jacksonville, Inc. ("CIS") has operated an afterschool and summer program at Carter G. Woodson Elementary School for the past three years within the Out-of-School ("OST") Essential Services Category. This school was not listed as a possible site in the new Request For Proposal issued by the Kids Hope Alliance in March 2020 (the "RFP"), as, at the time of release, Duval County Public Schools ("DCPS") intended to close the school for the 2020-2021 school year. Since that time, DCPS has decided to keep the school open and would like students to continue to have access to these services.

Section 2. Amending 2019-511-E Second Revised Schedule M. 2019-511-E Second Revised Schedule M is hereby amended to include Community in Schools of Jacksonville, Inc., a copy of the Third Revised Schedule M is attached hereto as Exhibit 1.

Section 3. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code. The Kids Hope Alliance is hereby authorized to directly procure children's services from CIS for afterschool and summer programming at Carter G. Woodson Elementary School for the 2020-2021 school year and the immediately following summer in the amount of \$200,640.00. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such services are exempted from competitive solicitation because the children's services to be

provided by CIS are being approved in this authorizing legislation.

Section 4. Approval and authorization to execute. The Mayor, or his designee, the Corporation Secretary, and/or the Chief Executive Officer of the Kids Hope Alliance ("CEO") are hereby authorized to execute and deliver a contract with CIS for the children's services described in this legislation.

Section 5. Waiving the requirements of Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), Ordinance Code. The City hereby waives the requirements of Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), Ordinance Code, with respect to the children's services contract approved and authorized under Section 3 of this ordinance. Section 77.111(a) requires contracts for children's services to be competitively procured by the Kids Hope Alliance via an evaluated bid process. This waiver is needed in order to allow the Kids Hope Alliance to continue to support these CIS children's services that were not eligible to be included in the Kids Hope Alliance's most recent RFP for out-of-school time programming due to the DCPS' change in plans for Carter G. Woodson Elementary School.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
