Type of Action: Appointment confirmation

Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Sheriff's appointment of Edwin Cayenne, as Chief of Homeland Security Division in the Office of the Sheriff. The appointment and its confirmation shall be retroactive to September 21, 2024.

Background Information: Section 37.109(c), *Ordinance Code* provides that the Department of Investigations and Homeland Security shall include the following divisions each of which shall be headed by a division chief: (1) Investigations Division and (2) Homeland Security Division.

Section 37.102(a), *Ordinance Code* division chiefs in the Sheriff's Office shall have a college degree or at least five years' training and experience, be appointed by the Sheriff and confirmed by the Council.

Assistant Chief Cayenne holds a bachelor's degree from Jacksonville University and an MBA from the University of Phoenix. He has served with JSO since 1998 in various capacities including as a patrol officer, detective, sergeant, and most recently as Assistant Chief of Narcotics and Vice.

Fiscal Impact: The salary range for this position is \$107,432.64 - \$175,400.04 annually.
