5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$162,865.00 IN GRANT  
6 FUNDS FROM THE OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, U.S.  
7 DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021,  
8 AND APPROPRIATING \$67,040.00 FROM THE KIDS HOPE  
9 ALLIANCE TO COVER THE LOCAL MATCH FOR THE FIRST  
10 YEAR OF THE GRANT, TO FUND A COMPREHENSIVE ANTI-  
11 GANG PROGRAM FOR YOUTH KNOWN AS "PROJECT  
12 INSPIRE" AND TO FUND A CONTRACT MANAGER POSITION  
13 FOR OVERSIGHT OF THIS GRANT PROGRAM AND THE  
14 DIRECT SERVICE PROVIDER, AS INITIATED BY B.T.  
15 21-034; AUTHORIZING SAID CONTRACT MANAGER  
16 POSITION, AS INITIATED BY R.C. 21-058; INVOKING  
17 THE EXCEPTION TO SECTION 126.107(G), *ORDINANCE*  
18 *CODE*, WITH RESPECT TO SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY  
19 MANAGED ACCESS TO CHILD HEALTH, INC.; APPROVING  
20 AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND  
21 THE CORPORATION SECRETARY, AND/OR THE CHIEF  
22 EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE TO  
23 EXECUTE AND DELIVER A CONTRACT WITH MANAGED  
24 ACCESS TO CHILD HEALTH, INC.; WAIVING THE  
25 REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 77.111(A) (PROVIDER  
26 CONTRACTS), CHAPTER 77 (KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE),  
27 *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO EXEMPT THE SERVICES TO BE  
28 PROVIDED BY MANAGED ACCESS TO CHILD HEALTH, INC.  
29 FROM COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT; PROVIDING FOR  
30 OVERSIGHT BY THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE; PROVIDING  
31 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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2 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

3 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,  
4 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated  
5 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
6 listed in subsection (b):

13 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

14 The funding above includes \$162,865.00 in grant funds from  
15 the Office of Justice Programs, U.S. Department of Justice,  
16 with an additional appropriation of \$67,040.00 from the  
17 Kids Hope Alliance ("KHA") to cover the local match for  
18 the first year of the grant.

19 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
20 Section 1 is to fund the first year of a comprehensive anti-gang  
21 program for youth known as "Project INSPIRE" (Identifying Needs and  
22 Supports to Partner, Intervene, Reengage and Educate youth) (the  
23 "Program") for the period beginning October 1, 2020 through September  
24 30, 2021, with the overall term of the grant beginning October 1,  
25 2020 and ending September 30, 2023. A copy of the Department of  
26 Justice, Office of Justice Programs Juvenile Justice and Delinquency  
27 Prevention Grant Award (Award Number 2020-MU-MU-0047) has been placed  
28 **On File** with the Office of Legislative Services.

29 **Section 3. Authorization of Position.** There is hereby  
30 authorized the contract manager position more fully described in R.C.  
31 21-058, attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this

1 reference.

2           **Section 4.           Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g),**  
3 **Ordinance Code.**       KHA is hereby authorized to procure services  
4 from Managed Access to Child Health, Inc. as necessary to comply with  
5 grant requirements in connection with the Program authorized in  
6 Section 1 above. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part  
7 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), *Ordinance*  
8 *Code*, such services are exempted from competitive solicitation  
9 because the services to be provided are being approved via authorizing  
10 legislation pursuant to this ordinance.

11           **Section 5.           Approval and Authorization.** The Mayor, or his  
12 designee, and the Corporation Secretary, and/or the Chief Executive  
13 Officer of KHA are hereby authorized to execute and deliver a contract  
14 between KHA and Managed Access to Child Health, Inc. as is necessary  
15 to comply with grant requirements in connection with the Program  
16 authorized in Section 1.

17           **Section 6.           Waiver of the provisions in Chapter 77 (Kids**  
18 **Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts).** The City  
19 hereby waives the provisions in Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance),  
20 Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts) with respect to the contract  
21 with Managed Access to Child Health, Inc. approved and authorized in  
22 Section 5 of this ordinance. Section 77.111(a) requires contracts  
23 for children's services provided by third parties to be competitively  
24 procured by KHA via an evaluated bid process. This waiver is needed  
25 in order to allow KHA to meet grant requirements by directly  
26 contracting with Managed Access to Child Health, Inc. to provide  
27 Program services which was included in the approved grant application.

28           **Section 7.           Oversight Department.** The Kids Hope Alliance  
29 shall oversee administration of the grant and the Program.

30           **Section 8.           Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
31 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective

1 without the Mayor's signature.
