4 **RESOLUTION 2025-576**

5 A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING HOUSE BILL 987,  
6 DESIGNATING A PORTION OF STATE ROAD 10/WEST  
7 BEAVER STREET BETWEEN KING STREET AND ACORN  
8 STREET IN DUVAL COUNTY AS "HARRY FRISCH STREET";  
9 DIRECTING THE CHIEF OF THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES  
10 DIVISION TO SEND A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO  
11 THE DISTRICT TWO SECRETARY OF THE FLORIDA  
12 DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE MEMBERS OF  
13 THE DUVAL COUNTY LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION;  
14 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

16 **WHEREAS,** during the 2025 Legislative Session, the Florida  
17 Legislature passed House Bill 987, which makes honorary designations  
18 of transportation facilities throughout Florida and directs the  
19 Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to erect suitable markers  
20 for those designations; and

21 **WHEREAS,** House Bill 987 designates that portion of State Road  
22 10/West Beaver Street between King Street and Acorn Street in Duval  
23 County as "Harry Frisch Street"; and

24 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Section 334.071, *Florida Statutes*, a city  
25 or county commission must pass a resolution in support of a particular  
26 honorary designation before road markers are erected; and

27 **WHEREAS,** the City of Jacksonville wishes to honor Harry Frisch  
28 and requests that the FDOT erect suitable markers designating a  
29 portion of State Road 10/West Beaver Street between King Street and  
30 Acorn Street in Duval County as "Harry Frisch Street"; now therefore

31 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

1           **Section 1.**           The City Council strongly supports House Bill  
2 987, designating a portion of State Road 10/West Beaver Street between  
3 King Street and Acorn Street in Duval County as "Harry Frisch Street",  
4 and hereby authorizes the erection of appropriate signage by the  
5 Florida Department of Transportation to commemorate the designation.

6           **Section 2.           Directive to Chief of Legislative Services**  
7 **Division.**   The Chief of the Legislative Services Division is hereby  
8 directed to provide a copy of this Resolution to the District Two  
9 Secretary of the Florida Department of Transportation and the Duval  
10 County Legislative Delegation.

11           **Section 3.           Effective Date.**   This Resolution shall become  
12 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
13 without the Mayor's signature.
