5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$800,000 (\$400,000 IN  
6 GRANT FUNDS FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF  
7 CHILDREN AND FAMILIES, \$85,000 CASH MATCH FROM  
8 THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE JUVENILE JUSTICE  
9 PREVENTION & INTERVENTION ESSENTIAL SERVICE  
10 CATEGORY, AND \$315,000 IN IN-KIND CONTRIBUTION)  
11 TO IMPLEMENT THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE, MENTAL HEALTH,  
12 AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE REINVESTMENT GRANT PROGRAM  
13 (THE "PROGRAM") TO INCREASE PUBLIC SAFETY AND  
14 IMPROVE THE ACCESSIBILITY AND EFFECTIVENESS OF  
15 TREATMENT SERVICES FOR JUVENILES SUFFERING FROM  
16 MENTAL ILLNESS, SUBSTANCE ABUSE DISORDERS, OR  
17 CO-OCCURRING MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE  
18 DISORDERS, AND WHO ARE IN, OR AT RISK OF  
19 ENTERING, THE CRIMINAL OR JUVENILE JUSTICE  
20 SYSTEMS, FOR THE FIRST YEAR OF THE THREE (3)  
21 YEAR GRANT TERM BEGINNING JULY 1, 2021 THROUGH  
22 JUNE 30, 2022, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 21-092;  
23 AMENDING FIFTH REVISED SCHEDULE M TO ORDINANCE  
24 2020-511-E; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION TO SECTION  
25 126.107(G), *ORDINANCE CODE*, WITH RESPECT TO  
26 SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY MANAGED ACCESS TO  
27 CHILD HEALTH, INC.; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING  
28 THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION  
29 SECRETARY, AND/OR THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF  
30 THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE, TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER

1 A CONTRACT WITH MANAGED ACCESS TO CHILD HEALTH,  
2 INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES  
3 NECESSARY FOR LOCAL IMPLEMENTATION AND EXPANSION  
4 OF THE PROGRAM; WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF  
5 SECTION 77.111(A) (PROVIDER CONTRACTS), CHAPTER  
6 77 (KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE), *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO  
7 EXEMPT THE SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY MANAGED  
8 ACCESS TO CHILD HEALTH, INC. FROM COMPETITIVE  
9 PROCUREMENT; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE  
10 KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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12 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

13 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,  
14 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated  
15 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
16 listed in subsection (b):

23 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

24 The funding above comprises \$400,000.00 in grant funds from  
25 the Florida Department of Children and Families, an  
26 additional appropriation of \$85,000.00 from the Kids Hope  
27 Alliance ("KHA"), and \$315,000.00 in in-kind contribution  
28 consisting of security services provided by JSO at the  
29 Juvenile Assessment Center for implementation of the  
30 Criminal Justice, Mental Health and Substance Abuse  
31 Reinvestment Grant Program.

1           **Section 2.           Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
2 Section 1 is to fund the first year of local implementation and  
3 expansion of the Criminal Justice, Mental Health and Substance Abuse  
4 Reinvestment Grant Program (the "Program") for the period beginning  
5 July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022. The overall grant term is three  
6 (3) years beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2024. A copy  
7 of the Florida Department of Children and Families Criminal Justice,  
8 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Reinvestment Grant Award Notice #  
9 DCF RFA 2021-001 is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated  
10 herein by this reference. A copy of the budget schedule reflecting  
11 the intended sources and uses of funds for the first year of the  
12 grant is attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**.

13           **Section 3.           Amending Fifth Revised Schedule M to Ordinance**  
14 **2020-511-E.** There is hereby amended for the fiscal year 2020-2021  
15 budget for the Kids Hope Alliance by substituting in the place of  
16 Fifth Revised Schedule M, approved by Ordinance 2020-511-E, the Sixth  
17 Revised Schedule M, attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 4**, labeled as  
18 "Revised Exhibit 4, 6<sup>th</sup> Rev Sched M, September 7, 2021 - NCSPHS" and  
19 incorporated herein by this reference. The Sixth Revised Schedule M  
20 will reflect additional transfers and funds appropriated herein.

21           **Section 4.           Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g),**  
22 **Ordinance Code.** KHA is hereby authorized to procure professional  
23 services from Managed Access to Child Health, Inc. ("MATCH") for  
24 local implementation and expansion of the Program in compliance with  
25 the grant authorized in Section 1 above. Pursuant to Section  
26 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126  
27 (Procurement Code), *Ordinance Code*, such services are exempted from  
28 competitive solicitation because the services to be provided are  
29 being approved via authorizing legislation pursuant to this  
30 Ordinance.

31           **Section 5.           Approval and Authorization to Execute.** The

1 Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary, and/or the  
2 Chief Executive Officer of KHA, are hereby authorized to execute and  
3 deliver a contract between KHA and Managed Access to Child Health,  
4 Inc. pursuant to which MATCH will provide professional services  
5 necessary for local implementation and expansion of the Program in  
6 compliance with the grant authorized in Section 1.

7 **Section 6. Waiver of the requirements of Chapter 77 (Kids**  
8 **Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), Ordinance**  
9 **Code.** The City hereby waives the requirements of Chapter 77 (Kids  
10 Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), *Ordinance*  
11 *Code*, with respect to the contract with Managed Access to Child  
12 Health, Inc. approved and authorized in Section 5 of this Ordinance.  
13 Section 77.111(a) requires contracts for children's services provided  
14 by third parties to be competitively procured by KHA via an evaluated  
15 bid process. This waiver is needed in order to allow KHA to directly  
16 contract with Managed Access to Child Health, Inc. to provide the  
17 Program services included in the approved grant application.

18 **Section 7. Oversight Department.** The Kids Hope Alliance  
19 shall oversee administration of the grant and the Program.

20 **Section 8. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
21 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
22 without the Mayor's signature.
