8 ALLOCATING \$637,000 TO THE NEIGHBORHOODS
9 DEPARTMENT, MUNICIPAL CODE COMPLIANCE DIVISION,
10 AND THE BALANCE OF \$663,000 TO THE PUBLIC WORKS
11 DEPARTMENT, MOWING AND LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE
12 DIVISION, TO BE SPLIT BETWEEN MOWING AND
13 LANDSCAPE - PRIVATE PROPERTY (\$400,000) AND
14 MOWING AND LANDSCAPE - TREE REMOVAL (\$263,000),
15 TO PROCURE NUISANCE ABATEMENT CONTRACTUAL
16 SERVICES FOR THE REMOVAL OF PROPERTY CODE
17 VIOLATIONS THROUGHOUT THE CITY IN COMPLIANCE
18 WITH CHAPTER 518, *ORDINANCE CODE*, AS INITIATED
19 BY B.T. 22-044; PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION;
20 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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22 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

23 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,
24 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
25 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
26 listed in subsection (b):

2 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

3 The funding above comprises available revenues from the
4 Nuisance Abatement Lien Special Revenue Fund pursuant to
5 Section 111.470, *Ordinance Code*, that will be used for
6 nuisance abatement contractual services.

7 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
8 Section 1 is to provide funding for nuisance abatement contractual
9 services for the removal of property code violations throughout the
10 city in accordance with Chapter 518, *Ordinance Code*. A total of
11 \$637,000 is allocated to the Neighborhoods Department, Municipal Code
12 Compliance Division, and the remaining \$663,000 is allocated to the
13 Public Works Department, Mowing and Landscape Maintenance Division
14 to be split between Mowing and Landscape - Private Property (\$400,000)
15 and Mowing and Landscape - Tree Removal (\$263,000), for the
16 procurement of these contractual services.

17 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall
18 become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming
19 effective without the Mayor's signature.
