6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$66,000.00 IN GRANT  
7 FUNDING FROM THE NATIONAL HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY  
8 ADMINISTRATION ("NHTSA") FUNDED THROUGH THE FY  
9 23-24 STATE AND COMMUNITY HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY  
10 PROGRAM, THROUGH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF  
11 TRANSPORTATION ("FDOT"), TO THE PSBU  
12 GRANTS/OCCUPANT PROTECTION PROJECT FY24 TO  
13 INCREASE SAFETY BELT USE, AS INITIATED BY B.T.  
14 24-052; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR  
15 HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY, TO  
16 EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE  
17 CITY OF JACKSONVILLE (THE "CITY") THAT CERTAIN  
18 STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION  
19 (FDOT) SUBGRANT FOR HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY FUNDS  
20 NUMBER G2S39 BETWEEN THE CITY AND FDOT;  
21 PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE  
22 SHERIFF'S OFFICE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

24 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

25 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,  
26 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
27 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
28 listed in subsection (b):

4 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

5 The funding above represents an appropriation of grant  
6 funds from the National Highway Traffic Safety  
7 Administration ("NHTSA") funded through the FY 23-24 State  
8 and Community Highway Traffic Safety Program, through the  
9 Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") to the PSBU  
10 Grants/Occupant Protection Project FY24 to perform  
11 overtime operations to increase safety belt use. No local  
12 match is required.

13 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
14 Section 1 is to utilize grant funding to perform High-Visibility  
15 Enforcement (HVE) operations in high-frequency crash areas that  
16 target occupant protection by increasing safety belt use and will  
17 cover expenses for overtime and certain related benefits for law  
18 enforcement officers. The term of the grant, and period of  
19 performance, shall begin upon the City and FDOT's execution of that  
20 certain State of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Subgrant  
21 for Highway Traffic Safety Funds Number G2S39 between the City and  
22 FDOT (the "Grant Agreement"), and shall end on September 30, 2024.  
23 The Grant Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions of the grant.

24 **Section 3. Approval and Authorization to Execute**  
25 **Agreements.** There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee,  
26 and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and  
27 deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Grant Agreement in  
28 substantially the same form as placed **On File** with the Office of  
29 Legislative Services, and any respective extensions or amendments  
30 thereto as necessary and appropriate to effectuate the intent of this  
31 Ordinance.

1           **Section 4.       Oversight.**   The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office  
2 shall oversee administration of the grant and project described  
3 herein.

4           **Section 5.       Effective Date.**   This Ordinance shall become  
5 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
6 without the Mayor's signature.
