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The funding above represents an appropriation of grant funds from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration ("NHTSA") funded through the FY 23-24 State and Community Highway Traffic Safety Program, through the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") to the PSBU Grants/Occupant Protection Project FY24 perform to overtime operations to increase safety belt use. No local match is required.

13 Section 2. The purpose of the appropriation in Purpose. 14 Section 1 is to utilize grant funding to perform High-Visibility 15 Enforcement (HVE) operations in high-frequency crash areas that 16 target occupant protection by increasing safety belt use and will cover expenses for overtime and certain related benefits for law 17 18 enforcement officers. Section 4. Oversight. The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office
 shall oversee administration of the grant and project described
 herein.

4 Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become
