A RESOLUTION HONORING AND CONGRATULATING MAYOR LENNY CURRY'S CHIEF OF STAFF LEEANN KRIEG FOR HER 11 YEARS OF EFFECTIVE SERVICE TO THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Leeann Meredith Krieg, a lifelong resident of Jacksonville, Florida, and current resident of the vibrant Avondale neighborhood, has committed over a decade of unwavering service to the city's government; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Krieg embarked on her public service journey in 2011 with an unexpected entry into the political sphere, where she played an instrumental role in managing the campaign for Greg Anderson, Candidate for City Council At-Large Group 4, and following the victory in a countywide race, joined the City of Jacksonville in 2012 as Councilmember Anderson's Executive Council Assistant; and
