A RESOLUTION HONORING AND CONGRATULATING THE UNIVERSITY CHRISTIAN SCHOOL FAST PITCH SOFTBALL TEAM ON WINNING THE CLASS 2A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the University Christian School's Fast Pitch Softball Team culminated their exemplary season by securing a victory on May 23rd, 2023, against tough opponents from Fort Myers Evangelical Christian School, with a final score of 3-2, thus earning the Class 2A State Championship title; and

WHEREAS, this victory marked the first State Championship for the University Christian program and for the respected and dedicated coach Keith Stroud, who has cultivated athletic excellence and spirit in his teams for 39 years, 32 of which were spent at University Christian; and

WHEREAS, the team finished with a record of 23-2, concluding the playoffs having won 13-0 against St. Joseph Academy in the Regional Quarterfinals, won 12-1 against North Florida Christian in the Regional Semi-Finals, won 8-3 against Providence School in the Regional Championships, and finally in the close matchup of 3-2 in the Class 2A State Championship against the Fort Myers Evangelical Christian Sentinels; and

WHEREAS, this historic achievement was enabled by the remarkable contributions of the school's four graduating seniors - Kyla Bennett, Macie Bourgholtzer, Emma Reynolds, and Jahliyah Robinson - whose experience, leadership, and unwavering commitment were instrumental in guiding the young team to this milestone. The team, composed of many underclassmen, has matured and faced trials together, and

ultimately surmounted the final obstacle together, thereby positioning themselves as strong contenders to defend their title; and

WHEREAS, the hard-fought championship game was marked by pivotal performances, with Jaleigha Harris driving in the winning run in the bottom of the fifth, and pitcher Sophia Kardatzke brilliantly capping her junior season. As the Fort Myers Evangelical Christian Sentinels posed a significant challenge in the final inning, placing two runners on base with no outs, University Christian forced an out on a baserunning misstep, followed by a crucial Kardatzke strikeout, and a game-ending line out to shortstop Elissa Murdock, sealing the victory for the Christians; and

WHEREAS, this historic achievement for the University Christian Fast Pitch Softball Team has brought immense pride and joy to their school, their families, and their community, enhancing the tradition of athletic excellence at University Christian; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:
