ORDINANCE 2026-630

AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF COREY FORD, A DUVAL COUNTY RESIDENT, TO THE CONSTRUCTION TRADES QUALIFYING BOARD AS A CITIZEN NOT ASSOCIATED WITH THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY, REPLACING DAVID L. ROBERTSON, PURSUANT TO SECTION CHAPTER 62 (CONSTRUCTION TRADES QUALIFYING BOARD), *ORDINANCE CODE*, FOR A FIRST FULL TERM TO EXPIRE ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2028; WAIVING SUBSECTION 62.101(G), *ORDINANCE CODE*, AS TO THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE APPOINTEE NOT BE ASSOCIATED WITH THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appointment. The City Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment of Corey Ford, a Duval County resident, to the Construction Trades Qualifying Board as a citizen not associated with the construction industry, replacing David L. Robertson, pursuant to Chapter 62 (Construction Trades Qualifying Board), *Ordinance Code*, for a first full term to expire on September 30, 2028.

Section 2. Waiver of Subsection 62.101(g), Ordinance Code. Subsection 62.101(g), Section 62.101 (Board Establishment), Chapter 62 (Construction Trades Qualifying Board), *Ordinance Code*, is hereby waived as to the requirement that two voting members of the Construction Trades Qualifying Board be "citizens who are not associated with the construction industry." Mr. Ford is a Journeyman

1 Electrician currently employed by the International Brotherhood of
2 Electrical Workers, which is a profession associated with the
3 construction industry.

4 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
5 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
6 without the Mayor's signature.
