BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation of \$125,000 from the FOBT Pipeline, Inc. - Contingency account to the Local Initiative Support Corporation Subsidies and Contributions to Private Org account to provide funding to Local Initiative Support Corporation d/b/a LISC Jacksonville ("LISC") for the Small Business Employment Re-Grant Program (the "Program").

Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 2. Section 1 is to provide City grant funds to LISC for the Program as described in Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev Term Sheet & Budget, August 5, 2025 - Finance" attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. The Program is designed to assist small and micro-businesses in Duval County by providing reimbursable employment grants to qualified entities to address capital gaps often experienced by small businesses. 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Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated herein shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2025-2026.

grant funds are intended to provide business growth and expansion

opportunities via retention and creation of new jobs and will be

awarded in amounts that range from \$5,000 to \$20,000 per subrecipient.

LISC will act as the lead agency administering the Program to oversee

the grant application, scoring and award process as outlined in

Revised Exhibit 2. In addition, LISC will ensure each subrecipient

seeking reimbursement for qualified expenses under the Program has

expenditures reflecting adherence to applicable City Codes and

policies, as well as appropriate contract terms, prior to requesting

funds from the City for reimbursement.

Section 4. Waiver of Section 118.107, Ordinance Code. The provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for a direct contract with Local Initiatives Support Corporation d/b/a LISC Jacksonville. LISC is uniquely situated to administer this Program because it has a long history of working with small and micro-businesses.

Section 5. Waiver of Subsection 118.301(a)(3)(iii), Ordinance Code. Subsection 118.301(a)(3)(iii) (Expenditure of appropriated funds), Part 3 (Administration of City Grants), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, is hereby waived to allow a portion of the City funds to be used for contributions and donations to other groups or organizations through the Program. This waiver is justified because the City funds will be allocated to qualified small and micro-businesses through a competitive grant process for employment programs/employee costs. This provides an opportunity for targeted distribution of City funds to help grow small businesses by creating

and maintaining jobs in Duval County.

Section 6. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City an agreement with Local Initiatives Support Corporation d/b/a LISC Jacksonville in an amount not-to-exceed \$125,000, subject to the Scope of Services and Budget more particularly described in Revised Exhibit 2, for a term commencing on June 1, 2025 through May 31, 2026, and all other contracts and documents, including extensions, renewals and amendments to the agreement, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the General Counsel, or his or her designee, and the City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance and indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601, Ordinance Code.

Section 7. Oversight Department. The Grants and Contract Compliance Division of the Finance Department shall oversee the grant described herein.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
