ORDINANCE 2024-630

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE PROPOSED OCTOBER 1, 2024 - SEPTEMBER 30, 2027 COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE (FOP), REPRESENTING APPROXIMATELY 2,500 MEMBERS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Proposed Collective Section 1. Bargaining Agreements between the City of Jacksonville and Fraternal Order of Police Those certain proposed October 1, 2024 - September 30, Approved. Collective Bargaining Agreements between the Jacksonville and the Fraternal Order of Police (FOP) (collectively, the "FOP Collective Bargaining Agreements"), copies of which have been placed On File with the Office of Legislative Services, are hereby approved. FOP represents approximately 2,500 members with four collective bargaining units: (1) Police Officers through Sergeants; (2) Lieutenants and Captains; (3) Rank and File Corrections Officers; and (4) Supervisory Corrections Officers. The proposed FOP agreements have been agreed to in collective bargaining and have been ratified by the union membership.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance and all elements of the FOP Collective Bargaining Agreements shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
