Type of Action: Declaration and disposition of surplus property; designation of oversight agency; provision for property reversion; request for emergency passage on introduction

Bill Summary: The bill declares as surplus a 2012 Chevrolet Silverado crew cab pickup truck and authorizes its transfer to the Volunteer Life Saving Corps Inc. in Jacksonville Beach. It designates the Fire and Rescue Department to monitor the recipient's use of the vehicle to ensure its use in accordance with public purpose of providing supplemental ocean rescue and lifeguarding services on Jacksonville Beach. The bill contains a reverter clause providing that the vehicle shall be returned to the City in the event it is not used for the intended public purpose. Emergency passage on first reading is requested.

Background Information: The truck has 124,212 miles on the odometer and is rated by Fleet Management to be in poor condition. It will be provided to the Volunteer Life Saving Corps Inc. at Jacksonville Beach, which has resumed providing supplemental lifeguard services to that city's professional lifeguards after the settlement of a lawsuit stemming from a dispute over the application of labor laws to professional and volunteer lifeguards.

Policy Impact Area: Beach lifeguard service provision.

Fiscal Impact: The vehicle's value is approximately \$11,800, title to be transferred at no cost to Volunteer Life Saving Corps Inc.
