8 AN ORDINANCE REALLOCATING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF  
9 \$504,583 PREVIOUSLY ALLOCATED TO BRIDGES TO THE  
10 CURE, LLC AND TRANSFERRING SUCH FUNDING TO THE  
11 POTTER'S HOUSE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT EMPOWERING  
12 CENTER, INC. ("POTTER'S HOUSE") TO PROVIDE  
13 EXPANDED PROGRAM SERVICES AND FURTHER  
14 IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CURE VIOLENCE MODEL IN  
15 NORTHWEST AND NORTH JACKSONVILLE TARGET AREAS;  
16 APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS  
17 DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO  
18 EXECUTE A CONTRACT AMENDMENT WITH POTTER'S HOUSE  
19 TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM INDEBTEDNESS BY \$504,583  
20 AND TO EXPAND THE SCOPE OF SERVICES TO BE  
21 PROVIDED BY POTTER'S HOUSE, AND ANY AND ALL  
22 DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF  
23 THIS ORDINANCE; AMENDING REVISED EXHIBIT 5 TO  
24 ORDINANCE 2022-504-E; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY  
25 THE FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION DEPARTMENT,  
26 OFFICE OF GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE;  
27 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.  
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29 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

30 **Section 1. Purpose.** The purpose of the reallocation of  
31 \$504,583 from Bridges to the Cure, LLC to Potter's House is to fund

1 Potter's House with additional sums to provide an expanded scope of  
2 services including, coordination with the Mayor's Violence Reduction  
3 Center(s) to promote efficient delivery of participant case  
4 management and wrap around services and community engagement,  
5 detection and interruption of violent crime (murders and shootings),  
6 changing the norm of violence in the communities within the target  
7 areas, and changing the behaviors of high-risk individuals in  
8 Northwest and North Jacksonville, as attached hereto as **Revised**  
9 **Exhibit 2**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev Scope, February 6, 2023  
10 - NCSPHS". The City's contract with Bridges to the Cure, LLC ("BTC")  
11 was amended to provide a termination date of no later than February  
12 28, 2023, thereby freeing up funding previously allocated to BTC for  
13 the full 2022-2023 fiscal year to be reallocated to Potter's House  
14 to enable the provision of expanded services to the City.

15 **Section 2. Approval and Authorization to Execute.** The  
16 Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby  
17 authorized to execute and deliver a contract amendment (the  
18 "Amendment") between the City of Jacksonville and Potter's House to  
19 increase the maximum indebtedness of the contract by \$504,583 and to  
20 expand the Scope of Services to encompass those set forth on **Revised**  
21 **Exhibit 2** attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.  
22 The Amendment may include such additions, deletions and changes as  
23 may be reasonable, necessary and incidental for carrying out the  
24 purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the Mayor, or his designee,  
25 with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of  
26 the Amendment by the Mayor, or his designee; provided however, no  
27 modifications to the Amendment may increase the financial obligations  
28 of the City to an amount in excess of the amount stated in the  
29 Amendment or decrease the duties and obligations of Potter's House,  
30 and any such modifications shall be technical only and shall be  
31 subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the Office of

1 General Counsel and the Office of Risk Management for appropriate  
2 insurance and indemnification terms. For the purposes of this  
3 Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes  
4 having no financial impact to the City, and any other non-substantive  
5 changes that do not substantively increase the duties and  
6 responsibilities of the City under the provisions of the Agreement.  
7 The Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary, are further  
8 hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the  
9 City, any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of  
10 this Ordinance, including closing and other related documents  
11 relative to the forgivable loan.

12 **Section 3. Amending 2022-504-E, the FY 2022-2023 Budget**  
13 **Ordinance, to replace the Revised Exhibit 5 to reflect the reallocated**  
14 **funding for the Cure Violence program.** 2022-504-E, the FY 2022-2023  
15 Budget Ordinance, is hereby amended to replace the Revised Exhibit  
16 5, entitled "Cure Violence Jacksonville Suppliers and Scope of  
17 Services FY 2022-2023", in order to reflect the reallocation of  
18 funding from BTC to Potter's House for the Cure Violence program. The  
19 Second Revised Exhibit 5 is attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**.

20 **Section 4. Oversight Department.** The Finance and  
21 Administration Department, Office of Grants and Contract Compliance,  
22 shall oversee the project and agreement described herein.

23 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
24 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
25 without the Mayor's signature.
