## ORDINANCE 2019-735-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$327,336.90 FROM COUNTYWIDE INTERSECTION IMP, BRGE-BRIDGES TO SAN CLERC ROAD PEDESTRIAN BRIDGES FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF TWO PEDESTRIAN BRIDGES AND HANDRAILING, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 19-125; AMENDING THE 2020-2024 FIVE-YEAR PROGRAM CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2019-505-E TO REDUCE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT ENTITLED "COUNTYWIDE INTERSECTION IMP, BRGE-BRIDGES" AND PROVIDE FUNDING FOR PROJECT ENTITLED "SAN CLERC ROAD PEDESTRIAN BRIDGES"; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Appropriation. For the 2019-2020 fiscal year, Section 1. within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

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The funding above is a transfer of funds from Countywide Intersection IMP, Brge-Bridges to San Clerc Road Pedestrian Bridges for the design and construction of two pedestrian bridges and handrailing. This is a reappropriation of existing dollars. Once the project is completed, any unspent dollars shall revert to 143/PWCP143RD549/06505/PW0381-02.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 above is to fund the design and construction of two predestrian bridges and handrailing. The existing wooden pedestrian bridges are impassable and unsafe. This pedestrian project will replace the bridge deck structure while leaving the existing pilings.

CIP Amendment. Ordinance 2019-505-E, being Section 3. the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reduce funding for the project entitled "Countywide intersection IMP, Brge-Bridges" and provide funding for the project entitled "San Clerc Road Pedestrian Bridges." The projects are more fully described in the Project Information Sheets, attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as Revised Exhibit 2, Revised CIP, November 4, 2019 - TEU" and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will result in the unnecessary delay of replacing crtical transporation infrastructure. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of twothirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2019-505-E. In all other

respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by 1 Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue in full force and effect. 2 3 Section 4. Effective Date.
