The grant will help cover the costs of hiring 40 new police officers. After completing training the 40 new officers will be assigned to patrol duties and 40 veteran officers will implement the project. The project will focus on fighting violent crime by: 1) identifying and arresting Jacksonville's most prolific shooters, and 2) conducting data driven enforcement activities throughout Jacksonville. The grant provides \$125,000 per position over a 36-month period (totaling \$5,000,000.00) and requires a cash match of \$2,241,550.00 over the grant period. Grantees are required to cover the full cost of the positions for 12 months following the conclusion of the 36-month project.
