Bill Summary: This bill is an appropriation of \$135,479.45 in grant funds from the US Department of Health and Human Services HIV Emergency Relief Project Grant, originally appropriated pursuant to Ordinance 2024-504-E. The positions of Planning Council Support Assistant and Ryan White-Assistant Director are approved. The Social Services Division of the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department will provide oversight.

Background Information: After an audit, the US Department of Health and Human Services recommended the addition of two full-time positions within the Social Services Division of the Parks, Recreation, and Community Services Department: Planning Council Support Assistant and Ryan White-Assistant Director. These positions will provide services related to the City's HIV-related health and support services provided through the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Part A Program. These services are provided to individuals living with HIV/AIDS residing in the Jacksonville Transitional Grant Area (comprised of Duval, Clay, Nassau, and St. Johns counties).

Policy Impact Area: Ryan White Care Act of 1990 Title I program staffing

Fiscal Impact: \$135,479.45 grant funds from the US Department of Health and Human Services, with no City match required as initiated by BT 25-059.
