5 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE
6 MEDICAL DIRECTOR OF THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND
7 RESCUE DEPARTMENT TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR
8 AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, THE VACCINE
9 ADMINISTRATION MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN
10 THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND THE CITY
11 OF JACKSONVILLE; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY
12 THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT;
13 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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15 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

16 **Section 1. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby
17 approved, and the Medical Director of the Jacksonville Fire and
18 Rescue Department (JFRD) is hereby authorized to execute and
19 deliver on behalf of the City, the Vaccine Administration
20 Memorandum of Agreement between the Florida Department of Health
21 and the City of Jacksonville, a copy of which is attached hereto as
22 **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by this reference (the "MOA").
23 The JFRD is required to administer the Hepatitis A vaccine to all
24 uniformed personnel according to the Collective Bargaining
25 Agreement. Pursuant to the MOA, JFRD will receive Hepatitis A
26 vaccine for free from the Florida Department of Health (DOH) if
27 JFRD's Wellness Program administers the vaccine to firefighters.
28 The vaccine will protect firemen from contracting Hepatitis A and
29 incurring medical expenses. JFRD will not incur any costs under the
30 MOA, and there are no matching funds required.

31 **Section 2. Oversight.** JFRD shall oversee the project

1 described herein.

2 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
3 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
4 without the Mayor's signature.
