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## ORDINANCE 2023-444

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING THE FUTURE POTENTIAL RELOCATION OF THE EXISTING JOHN E. GOODE PRE-TRIAL DETENTION FACILITY ("DUVAL COUNTY JAIL") LOCATED AT 500 E. ADAMS STREET, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA, 32202, AND CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW DUVAL COUNTY JAIL; INVOKING THE EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.107(G) (EXEMPTIONS), PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A CONSULTING SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE ("CITY") AND CGL COMPANIES, LLC, A DELAWARE LIMITED LIAIBLITY COMPANY ("CGL COMPANIES"), TO PROVIDE GENERAL CRIMINAL JUSTICE FACILITY CONSULTING AND ADVISORY SERVICES REGARDING THE DUVAL COUNTY JAIL; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A CONSULTING SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND CGL COMPANIES FOR GENERAL CRIMINAL JUSTICE FACILITY CONSULTING AND ADVISORY SERVICES REGARDING THE DUVAL COUNTY JAIL; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT AND FUNDING BY THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Whereas, the existing John E. Goode Pre-trial Detention Facility ("Duval County Jail") located at 500 E. Adams Street, Jacksonville, Florida, 32202, currently serves over 3500 inmates; and

Whereas, the Duval County Jail is over 30 years old and in need of a current facility condition assessment to determine if extensive renovations or a new facility is needed; and

Whereas, the City has had recent discussions regarding the future potential relocation of the Duval County Jail outside of the City's Downtown urban core area, and the Duval County Jail relocation is listed as a beyond-the-fifth-year capital project in the City's Capital Improvement Program; and

Whereas, the City desires to fact-find, study, and conceptually explore the future potential relocation of the Duval County Jail to better position and educate the City on a future relocation through a series of City Council led public meetings and discussions (the "City Council Special Committee") involving various City stakeholders, including, but not limited to, the Jacksonville Sherriff's Office, Public Defender, State Attorney, Courts, Clerk of the Court, and a hosts of non-profits and for profits entities interested in the Duval County Jail relocation; and

Whereas, CGL Companies, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("CGL Companies"), has over 40 years' experience in criminal justice facility consulting services nationwide; and

Whereas, the City desires to direct contract with CGL Companies to assist the City, including the City Council Special Committee, and provide general criminal justice facility consulting and advisory services regarding the Duval County Jail as provided herein; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Recitals. The Recitals above are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to procure the professional services of CGL Companies to provide general criminal

justice facility consulting and advisory services regarding the future potential relocation of the existing Duval County Jail and construction of a new Duval County Jail. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempt from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation. Except for the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

## Section 3. Approval and Authorization to Consulting Services Agreement between the City and CGL Companies. The Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City a consulting services agreement ("Consulting Agreement") with CGL Companies to provide general criminal justice facility consulting and advisory services regarding the Duval County Jail in an amount not-to-exceed \$50,000.00, subject to the Scope of Services and hourly rates more particularly described in Exhibit 1, for a term commencing upon the City's execution of the Consulting Agreement through June 30, 2024, with a one (1) year renewal. Additionally, the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City all other contracts and documents regarding the Consulting Agreement, including extensions, renewals and amendments thereto, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, subject to appropriate legal review by the Office of General Counsel and approval by the City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance and indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601,

Section 4. Oversight and Funding. The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office shall oversee and provide funding for the Consulting
