**Type of Action:** Appropriation; CIP amendment

**Bill Summary:** This bill appropriates \$2,096,681.71, including \$1,110,573.00 from the Countywide Traffic Signalization—Fiber Optic Project, \$700,00 from the Countywide Intersection Improvements Project, and \$286,108.71 from the Countywide Roadway Sign Stripe and Signal Project, to various projects, as initiated by BT 26-029. The bill also amends the 2026-2030 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan, as approved by Ordinance 2025-505-E, to reflect the appropriations.

**Background Information:** The six projects funded by this appropriation include:

1. \$150,325.50 to the Monument Road Pedestrian Crossing project
2. \$135,783.21 to the St. Johns Bluff Road and Lost Pine Drive Signalized U-turn project
3. \$350,000.00 to the Golfair Boulevard and APR Academy Pedestrian Crossing project
4. \$350,000.00 to the Overhead Pedestrian Signal—Soutel Drive at Morris Manor project
5. \$643,863.00 to the Fort Caroline Road Fiber Optic project
6. \$475,710.00 to the St Augustine Road Fiber Optic project
