Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Mayor's appointment of Susan A. Ticker, to the Public Service Grant Council, pursuant to Section 80.102, Chapter 80, *Ordinance Code*, replacing Linae Parkinson, for a partial term to expire on December 31, 2024, followed by a first full term to expire December 31, 2027.

Background Information: The Public Service Grant Council is established pursuant to Chapter 80, *Ordinance Code*, and charged with the review and evaluation of all Public Service Grant applications and responsibility for making funding recommendations to the Mayor and City Council for Public Service Grants.

Section 80.102, *Ordinance Code*, provides that the Public Service Grant Council shall consist of 15 voting members, eight of whom shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by City Council. Members of the Public Service Grant Council shall be chosen to provide community diversity and knowledge of needed services; shall demonstrate an interest in the impact of public service programs in the community, and a willingness to participate fully in the Public Service Grant application process. A minimum of two Mayoral appointees and two City Council appointees shall have prior experience with grant processes.

Ms. Ticker holds a bachelor's degree from Brown University, an MBA from Rutgers Graduate School of Management and is a Davidson Graduate School of Education, Jewish Theological Seminary Doctoral candidate. She is a teacher and consultant for the Jacksonville Jewish Center. Ms. Ticker resides in Duval County in council district 6.
