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ORDINANCE 2024-553

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$50,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND OPERATING, CLEAN COMMUNITIES INITIATIVE CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE GENERAL FUND OPERATING, SPECIALIZED EQUIPMENT ACCOUNT WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR THE PURCHASE OF TRASH RECEPTACLES FROM BIG BELLY SOLAR, LLC, TO BE INSTALLED ALONG COMMERCIAL CORRIDORS IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 7 AT SPECIFIC LOCATIONS IDENTIFIED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER TO FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025; APPROVAL AND AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH BIG BELLY SOLAR, LLC, FOR THE PURCHASE INSTALLATION OF TRASH RECEPTACLES; INVOKING THE EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.108(G) (EXEMPTIONS FROM COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION), SUBPART A (GENERAL REGULATIONS), PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS; ETHICS AND TRANSPARENCY IN PUBLIC CONTRACTING), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation of \$50,000 from the General Fund Operating, Clean Communities Initiative Contingency account to the General Fund Operating, Specialized Equipment account within the Department of Public Works for the purchase and installation of trash receptacles from Big Belly Solar, LLC, in Council District 7.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for the purchase and installation of trash receptacles from Big Belly Solar, LLC, in Council District 7 as described in Quote No. Q43177-2 provided to the City for this purpose. The trash receptacles will be installed along commercial corridors in Five Points along Park Street and in Murray Hill along Edgewood Avenue South in the locations listed and depicted in Exhibit 2, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, or as close thereto as is reasonably practicable as determined by the City's Public Works Department. The Solid Waste Division of Public Works will assume responsibility for trash collection and any required maintenance of the trash receptacles not provided by Big Belly Solar, LLC.

Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated herein shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2024-2025.

Section 4. Approval and Authorization to Execute. The Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute an agreement, including

amendments thereto, with Big Belly Solar, LLC, in a not-to-exceed amount of \$50,000.00 for the purchase and installation of trash receptacles in Council District 7 as more specifically described herein.

Section 5. Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.108(g), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Big Belly Solar, LLC, for the purchase and installation of trash receptacles in Five Points and Murray Hill in Council District 7 as described herein. Pursuant to Section 126.108(g) (Exemptions from competitive solicitation), Subpart A (General Regulations), Part 1 (General Regulations; Ethics and Transparency in Public Contracting), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. Oversight. The Department of Public Works shall have oversight of the project described herein.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
