Bill Summary: The bill authorizes JSO to enforce Vizcaya at Hodges' neighborhood speed limit of 20 MPH. The bill authorizes the Administration to execute a Traffic Control Agreement with Vizcaya at Hodges Homeowners' Association, Inc., pursuant to Section 316.006, Florida Statutes, for municipal traffic control jurisdiction by the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office over the limited access roads located within the boundaries of the Vizcaya at Hodges community.

Background Information: The Board of Directors of Vizcaya at Hodges Homeowners' Association, Inc., on June 26, 2019, voted to allow the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office to enter Vizcaya at Hodges Homeowners' Association, Inc. property to perform such traffic controls and approved entering into a contract with City via JSO. The internal roads of the Vizcaya at Hodges community are private, and the speed limit has been posted at a maximum of 20 miles per hour.

Policy Impact Area: JSO, municipal traffic

Fiscal Impact: Nominal revenue from traffic citations is anticipated. No other fiscal impacts are anticipated.
