ORDINANCE 2023-554

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CHAPTER 745 (ADDRESSING 5 AND STREET NAMING REGULATIONS) ORDINANCE CODE; 6 7 TO OFFICIALLY DECLARE THAT "RACETRACK" ROAD 8 EXTENDING FROM PHILIPS HIGHWAY IN DUVAL COUNTY TO THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY BOUNDARY LINE SHOULD BE 9 DESIGNATED AS TWO SEPARATE WORDS AS "RACE TRACK" 10 11 ROAD; PROVIDING A COMPLIANCE TIME PERIOD TO 12 REQUIRE THAT ALL CITIZENS, PROPERTY OWNERS, 13 BUSINESS OWNERS AND GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES UTILIZE THE CORRECT DESIGNATION AND SPELLING OF 14 "RACETRACK" AS "RACE TRACK" ROAD ON ANY AND ALL 15 OFFICIAL DOCUMENTS, RESIDENCE ADDRESSES, STREET 16 17 HIGHWAY MARKERS AND ELECTRONIC SIGNS, COMMUNICATIONS ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2024; 18 DIRECTING THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES DIVISION TO 19 20 FORWARD THIS ORDINANCE TO THE PLANNING AND 21 DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT AND THE PUBLIC WORKS 22 DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, "Racetrack Road" extending from Philips Highway in Duval County to the St. Johns County Boundary Line has for many years been officially recognized by the City of Jacksonville as one word for purposes of street naming and addressing data. A map of "Race Track Road" is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**; and

29 WHEREAS, "Racetrack" Road extends into neighboring Saint Johns 30 County; and

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WHEREAS, a representative for the Saint Johns County Sheriff's

Office confirmed that St. John's County's addressing data systems officially recognizes "Race Track" Road as two separate words; and

WHEREAS, mapping applications such as Google Maps recognizes "Race Track" Road as two separate words; and

5 WHEREAS, the majority of City of Jacksonville street signs
6 include "Race Track" Road as two separate words; and

7 WHEREAS, the discrepancy between "Racetrack" and "Race Track"
8 has created confusion, and caused addressing data systems to perform
9 incorrectly; and

10 WHEREAS, the Council seeks to officially recognize and declare 11 that "Racetrack" Road extending from Philips Highway in Duval County 12 to the St. Johns County Boundary Line should be designated as "Race 13 Track" Road; and

WHEREAS, on July 5, 2023, the 911 Emergency Addressing Advisory 14 Committee voted to adopt the Staff recommendation for approval to 15 officially recognize and declare that "Racetrack" Road extending from 16 17 Philips Highway in Duval County to the St. Johns County Boundary Line should be designated and spelled as "Race Track" Road. A copy of the 18 19 911 Committee Powerpoint presentation, and the excerpt minutes of the July 5, 2023 public meeting of the 911 Emergency Addressing Advisory 20 Committee are attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**; and 21

WHEREAS, the Council finds it appropriate to officially recognize and declare that "Racetrack Road" extending from Philips Highway in Duval County to the St. Johns County Boundary Line should be designated and spelled as "Race Track Road"; and

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. "Racetrack Road" officially recognized, spelled and declared as "Race Track Road" The official recognition, spelling and declaration of the name of "Racetrack Road", extending from Philips Highway in Duval County to the St. Johns County Boundary line, is hereby recognized as "Race Track Road" which name of such street shall be hereafter known and designated. A copy of the map of "Race Track Road" is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**.

3 Section 2. Compliance Time Period to Occur on or before 4 December 31, 2024. All citizens, property owners, business owners and 5 governmental entities shall utilize "Race Track Road" on any and all 6 official documents, residence addresses, street signs, highway 7 markers, and electronic communication on or before December 31, 2024.

8 Section 3. Legislative Services Division directed to 9 forward a copy to the Planning and Development Department and the Public Works Department. The Chief of Legislative Services is directed 10 11 to send a copy of this legislation once enacted to the Planning and 12 Development Department, Addressing Unit, and the Public Works Department for processing, implementation, and coordination with 911 13 14 Emergency, Fire and Rescue Department, the U.S. Postal Service, and other affected agencies and organizations. 15

16 Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become 17 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 18 without the Mayor's signature.
