**Type of Action:** Appointment Confirmation

**Bill Summary:** This bill confirms the Mayor's appointment of Wendy E. Byndloss as Executive Director of the Human Rights Commission.

**Background Information:** Section 60.102(b), *Ordinance Code*, provides that the Executive Director of the Human Rights Commission shall be appointed by the Mayor, subject to confirmation by the City Council. Further, Section 60.201, *Ordinance Code*, provides that the Executive Director of the Human Rights Commission is the Division Chief of the Equal Opportunity/Equal Access Division.

Ms. Byndloss works as the Assistant General Counsel at the Office of General Counsel for the City of Jacksonville and has been in that role since February 2014. Ms. Byndloss has a Juris Doctorate from George Washington University. She resides within Council District #7.
