Bill Summary:

This bill is an appropriation of \$666,784.00 in grant funds from the Department of Homeland Security/Federal Emergency Management Agency and a cash match from the City to support City of Jacksonville Fire and Rescue's Wellness and Fitness Program.

Background Information:

The purpose of this legislation is to appropriate \$606,167.27 in Firefighters Grant Funding from the Department of Homeland Security/Federal Emergency Management distributed by the Florida Department of Emergency Management and funded through the American Rescue Plan Act with an additional match from the City of \$ 60,616.73. The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department, Emergency Preparedness Division shall oversee the grant administration. The grant period is from July 3, 2021, through July 29, 2023.
