ORDINANCE 2024-40

ORDINANCE PROVIDING FORGIVENESS TO AN THE BOSELLI FOUNDATION, INC., A FLORIDA NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION ("THE BOSELLI FOUNDATION"), NON-COMPLIANCE FOR WTTH THE REPORTING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 118.201 (RELEASE OF APPROPRIATIONS), PART 2 (DISBURSEMENT OF CITY GRANTS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE; AUTHORIZING THE COUNCIL AUDITOR TO REMOVE THE BOSELLI FOUNDATION FROM THE CHAPTER 118 NON-COMPLIANCE LIST; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE OFFICE OF GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 118.201, Ordinance Code, requires that City grant recipients provide an accounting of City grant funding received and expended, either in the form of an annual report or audited financial statements depending on the amount of City grant funding received; and

WHEREAS, The Boselli Foundation, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit corporation ("The Boselli Foundation") received City grant funding through the Jacksonville Children's Commission (now known as Kids Hope Alliance) to operate several community-based afterschool programs during the City's 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 fiscal years;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City contracts and Section 118.201, The Boselli Foundation was required to provide an audit by August 28, 2017, for funds received in their fiscal year ended April 30, 2017, and report on any subsequent funding received; and

WHEREAS, The Boselli Foundation failed to provide the audit by

the required deadline and was therefore placed on the Council Auditor's Chapter 118 non-compliance list (the "Non-Compliance List") on August 29, 2017; and

WHEREAS, The Boselli Foundation is not eligible to receive further City grants due to it being on the Non-Compliance List; and

WHEREAS, The Boselli Foundation requests that the City Council forgive the non-compliance described above and authorize the Council Auditor to remove The Boselli Foundation from the Non-Compliance List; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals above are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. Forgiveness of Non-Compliance. The City Council forgives The Boselli Foundation's non-compliance with the requirement of Section 118.201, Ordinance Code, for failure to provide an audit for the 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 fiscal years by the required deadline.

Section 3. Removal from Non-Compliance List. The City Council authorizes the Council Auditor to remove The Boselli Foundation from the Non-Compliance List for the non-compliance described in Section 2 above.

Section 4. Oversight Department. The Office of Grants and Contract Compliance shall cooperate with the Council Auditor as needed to effectuate this ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
