Bill Summary: This bill is an appropriation of \$292,610.25 of grant funds from the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection ("FDEP") to develop the City of Jacksonville Adaptation Plan. The Office of Resiliency of the Planning and Development Department will provide oversight.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to provide funds for the creation of an Adaptation Strategy, to prioritize capital improvement projects based upon their respective resilience benefits. The term of the grant commenced on July 1, 2024, and continues through June 30, 2027. FDEP has determined that the costs for the Project are eligible for 100 percent reimbursement up to \$292,610.25, which was the amount of funds left over after the completion of the Vulnerability Assessment previously authorized by Ordinance 2023-761-E.
