The funding above is an appropriation of \$3,924,186.00 in annual federal HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) Grant Program funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the HOME program. funds are distributed on a formula basis to state and local governments to provide housing assistance eligible low- and very low-income households in a manner that best meets the local jurisdiction's housing needs. In addition, jurisdictions must match every dollar of HOME funds used (except for administrative costs) with 25 cents from non-federal sources, which may include donated materials or labor, the value of donated property, proceeds from bond financing, and other resources. City meets this match requirement by utilizing State Housing Initiative Partnership (SHIP) funds activities and recipients that are eligible under the HOME program.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for a wide range of housing assistance activities for eligible low- and very low-income individuals and families including building, buying, rehabilitating affordable housing for rent or homeownership, providing direct rental and other assistance to tenants and The HOME funds will be used for the City's Limited homebuyers. development subsidies for certified Community Repair Program, Housing Development Organizations (CHDOs), and a revolving loan fund for development of affordable housing. These funds will also cover the City's costs for administration and delivery of the HOME program.
