These funds will be used to support the State 30

Housing Initiatives Partnership ("SHIP") program. These

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supplemental SHIP program grant and income funds are being allocated pursuant to the 2023-2024 fiscal year SHIP formula grant and must be committed to eligible projects no later than June 30, 2025, and fully expended for completed projects no later than June 30, 2026.

Section 2. Purpose. The Florida Housing Finance Corporation provides funding to local governments as an incentive to create partnerships that produce and preserve affordable homeownership and multifamily housing. The SHIP program was designed to serve very low, low, and moderate-income families. SHIP funds may be used for emergency repairs, new construction, rehabilitation, down payment and closing costs assistance, impact fees, construction and gap financing, mortgage buy-downs, acquisition of property for affordable housing, matching dollars for federal housing grants and programs, homeownership counseling, and the Foreclosure Intervention Program. The above referenced funds are supplemental SHIP funds disbursed by the Florida Housing Finance Corporation that were originally held back for disaster recovery efforts. The updated Schedule of Proposed Funding detailing the proposed uses of the SHIP funds is attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. A copy of the updated State of Florida Projected SHIP Estimates for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 is attached hereto as Exhibit 3.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
