2	Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,

19	This pilot program provides career development and
20	on-the-job training opportunities for men and women

22	Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in
23	Section 1 is to provide funding from the City of Jacksonville to
24	Suited for Success for the Program as described in Exhibit 2, attached
25	hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. The Program is
26	designed to provide coaching, mentoring and training to ex-offenders
27	seeking employment and/or re-entry into the workforce. The City funds
28	appropriated herein will allow Suited for Success to assist 50
29	individuals seeking to obtain life-skills training and to increase
30	their employability. Participants in the Program will also receive
31	clothing suitable to wear during interviews when seeking employment.

Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.107(g), 1 Section 3. 2 The City is hereby authorized to directly procure Ordinance Code. 3 the professional services of Suited for Success Jacksonville, Inc. to administer the Program described herein. Pursuant to Section 4 5 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from 6 7 competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing 8 9 legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the 10 foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect. 11

Section 4. Waiver of Section 118.107, Ordinance Code. 12 The provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through 13 a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), 14 15 Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for a direct contract with Suited for Success Jacksonville, Inc. This 16 waiver is justified because Suited for Success has been providing 17 career development, employability and job readiness services for over 18 20 years. The City funds appropriated herein will allow Suited for 19 20 Success to expand its programming to reach additional at-risk men and 21 women who are transitioning from social services programs in Duval 22 County. This Program, combined with other wraparound services provided by Suited for Success, as well as it's connections within 23 24 the Jacksonville community mean this non-profit is well positioned 25 to have a significant impact on the City's ex-offender population and 26 their families.

27 Section 5. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is 28 hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation 29 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of 30 the City an agreement with Suited for Success Jacksonville, Inc. in 31 an amount not-to-exceed \$10,000, subject to the Scope of Services and

Budget more particularly described in **Exhibit 2**, for a term commencing 1 2 on October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024, and all other contracts 3 and documents, including extensions, renewals and amendments to the agreement, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate 4 the intent of this Ordinance, subject to appropriate legal review and 5 approval by the General Counsel, or his or her designee, and the 6 7 City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance and indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601, 8 9 Ordinance Code.

Section 6. Oversight Department. The Grants and
Contract Compliance Division of the Finance and Administration
Department shall oversee the project described herein.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
