6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$15,000 FROM THE
7 COUNCIL PRESIDENT'S DESIGNATED CONTINGENCY TO
8 THE GENERAL FUND - GENERAL SERVICES DISTRICT
9 SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO PRIVATE ORG
10 ACCOUNT TO PROVIDE A GRANT TO REVITALIZE
11 ARLINGTON, INC., FOR THE ENGAGE ARLINGTON
12 PROGRAM (THE "PROGRAM") AS DESCRIBED HEREIN;
13 PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER TO DECEMBER 31, 2024;
14 PROVIDING FOR REVERTER OF FUNDS; INVOKING THE
15 EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.108(G) (EXEMPTIONS FROM
16 COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION), PART 1 (GENERAL
17 REGULATIONS; ETHICS AND TRANSPARENCY IN PUBLIC
18 CONTRACTING), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE),
19 *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT
20 WITH REVITALIZE ARLINGTON, INC.; WAIVING SECTION
21 118.107 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH
22 A COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), PART 1
23 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS),
24 *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT
25 WITH REVITALIZE ARLINGTON, INC.; APPROVING, AND
26 AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE
27 CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON
28 BEHALF OF THE CITY A GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE
29 CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND REVITALIZE ARLINGTON,
30 INC. FOR THE PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY
31 THE GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF

1 THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
2 DATE.

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4 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

5 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,
6 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
7 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
8 listed in subsection (b):

15 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

16 The funding above is an appropriation of \$15,000 from the
17 Council President's Designated Contingency to the General
18 Fund - General Services District Subsidies and
19 Contributions to Private Org account to provide a grant to
20 Revitalize Arlington, Inc. ("Recipient" or "Revitalize
21 Arlington") for the Engage Arlington Program (the
22 "Program").

23 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
24 Section 1 is to provide funding from the City of Jacksonville to the
25 Recipient for the Program as described in **Exhibit 2**, attached hereto
26 and incorporated herein by this reference. The Program will include
27 introduction of a new healthy food and nutrition service through
28 which meal-kits and nutrition coaching will be provided for up to 36
29 to 40 residents over a period of three months. The intent is to
30 provide information and guidance regarding healthy cooking and
31 personal/family nutrition for residents in the Arlington area. In

1 addition to this new nutrition initiative, City funds will be used
2 to engage a facilitator who will provide two workforce and financial
3 literacy education events where attendees will learn about
4 responsible financial and economic practices and career readiness.

5 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated herein shall
6 not lapse but shall carryover to December 31, 2024.

7 **Section 4. Reverter.** Any funds remaining after completion
8 of the project described herein shall be returned to the account of
9 origin by January 31, 2025.

10 **Section 5. Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.108(g),**
11 **Ordinance Code.** The City is hereby authorized to directly procure
12 the professional services of Revitalize Arlington, Inc. to administer
13 the Program described herein. Pursuant to Section 126.108(g)
14 (Exemptions from competitive solicitation), Part 1 (General
15 Regulations; Ethics and Transparency in Public Contracting), Chapter
16 126 (Procurement Code), *Ordinance Code*, such procurement is exempted
17 from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are
18 to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing
19 legislation. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions
20 of Chapter 126, *Ordinance Code*, shall remain in full force and effect.

21 **Section 6. Waiver of Section 118.107, Ordinance Code.** The
22 provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through
23 a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions),
24 Chapter 118 (City Grants), *Ordinance Code*, are hereby waived to allow
25 for a direct contract with Revitalize Arlington, Inc. This waiver is
26 justified because the Recipient has maintained a long-standing
27 presence in the Arlington community including by offering food pantry
28 services. Revitalize Arlington, Inc. is therefore well suited to
29 develop and implement a program that targets the specific needs of
30 the community.

31 **Section 7. Approval and Authorization to Execute.** There is

1 hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation
2 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of
3 the City a grant agreement with Revitalize Arlington, Inc. in an
4 amount not-to-exceed \$15,000, subject to the Term Sheet and Budget
5 more particularly described in **Exhibit 2**, for a term commencing on
6 August 1, 2024 through November 30, 2024, and all other contracts and
7 documents, including extensions, renewals and amendments to the
8 agreement, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate
9 the intent of this Ordinance, subject to appropriate legal review and
10 approval by the General Counsel, or his or her designee, and the
11 City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance and
12 indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601,
13 *Ordinance Code*.

14 **Section 8. Oversight Department.** The Grants and Contract
15 Compliance Division of the Finance Department shall oversee the
16 project described herein.

17 **Section 9. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
18 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
19 without the Mayor's signature.
