Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to utilize funding from the City of Jacksonville Disabled Services Sponsorship Program to expand the REVAMP Duval project and equip all Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Division rescue units with sensory kits.
