7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$249,938, INCLUDING
8 \$187,453.50 IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE FEDERAL
9 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY ("FEMA"), THROUGH
10 THE STATE OF FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY
11 MANAGEMENT UNDER THE FEMA HAZARD MITIGATION
12 GRANT PROGRAM, AND \$62,484.50 FROM GENERAL FUND
13 RESERVE FOR FEDERAL PROGRAMS FOR THE REQUIRED
14 25% CITY MATCH, TO BE USED FOR INSTALLATION OF
15 WIND RESISTANT BAY DOORS AND HURRICANE SHUTTERS
16 AT THE COUNTY PORT SECURITY DISASTER WAREHOUSE
17 (THE "PROJECT"), AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T.
18 22-057; PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION; AMENDING THE
19 2022-2026 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN
20 APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2021-505-E TO REFLECT THIS
21 APPROPRIATION FOR THE PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR
22 OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE
23 DEPARTMENT, EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS DIVISION;
24 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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26 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

27 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,
28 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
29 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
30 listed in subsection (b):

7 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

8 The funding above represents an appropriation of a
9 \$187,453.50 grant from the Federal Emergency Management
10 Agency, distributed by the Florida Department of Emergency
11 Management, and an appropriation of \$62,484.50 in General
12 Fund Reserve for Federal Programs for the required 25% City
13 match, for installation of wind resistant bay doors and
14 hurricane shutters at the County Port Security Disaster
15 Warehouse. The grant period commences upon execution of
16 the Federally-Funded Subaward and Grant Agreement by both
17 parties and continues through February 29, 2024.

18 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
19 Section 1 is to fund the installation of code compliant wind resistant
20 bay doors and hurricane shutters at the County Port Security Disaster
21 Warehouse (one warehouse building) located at 909 Haines Street,
22 Jacksonville, Florida 32206 (the "Project"). These new bay doors and
23 hurricane-rated shutters will meet the wind speed requirements in the
24 area to prevent wind damage to this facility. All materials utilized
25 will provide protection against 143 mile per hour winds or the wind
26 speed protection and impact requirements of the Florida Building Code
27 at the time the permits are issued. A copy of the Federally-Funded
28 Subaward Grant Agreement (Agreement Number: H0795) providing the
29 terms and conditions relative to receipt and expenditure of the grant
30 funds has been placed **On File** with the Office of Legislative Services.

31 **Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance

1 2021-505-E, adopting the 2022-2026 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan
 2 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is
 3 hereby amended to provide additional funding for completion of the
 4 Project as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet
 5 attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2,
 6 Revised CIP, April 18, 2022 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this
 7 reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment
 8 of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be
 9 detrimental to the best interests of the community because such
 10 deferral will unnecessarily delay the urgent need to wind retrofit
 11 the Disaster Warehouse with compliant bay doors and shutters prior
 12 to expiration of the grant.

13 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of
 14 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
 15 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP
 16 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute
 17 an amendment to Ordinance 2021-505-E. In all other respects, the
 18 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2021-505-E
 19 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

20 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue
 21 Department, Emergency Preparedness Division shall oversee the Project
 22 and administration of the grant described herein.

23 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
 24 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
 25 without the Mayor's signature.
