5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$6,577.04 IN INTEREST  
6 EARNINGS AND PRIOR YEAR ROLLOVER GRANT FUNDS  
7 FROM THE ANNUAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES  
8 COUNTY GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT  
9 OF HEALTH, EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES DIVISION  
10 (THE "GRANT"), TO BE USED TOWARD THE PURCHASE OF  
11 TWO MOBILE ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE (ATV) RESCUE  
12 UNITS, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 22-076; PROVIDING  
13 FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND  
14 RESCUE DEPARTMENT, RESCUE DIVISION; PROVIDING AN  
15 EFFECTIVE DATE.

17 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

18 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,  
19 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
20 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
21 listed in subsection (b):

28 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

29 The funding above represents an appropriation of \$6,577.04  
30 in interest earnings and prior year rollover grant funds  
31 from the annual Emergency Medical Services County Grant

1 Award from the Florida Department of Health, Emergency  
2 Medical Services Division (the "Grant"). The Grant  
3 provides emergency medical services agencies funds for  
4 projects to acquire, repair, improve or upgrade emergency  
5 medical services in their communities. The funds  
6 appropriated by this legislation will be used toward the  
7 purchase of two mobile all-terrain vehicle (ATV) rescue  
8 units. No City match is required.

9 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
10 Section 1 is to use a combination of interest earned and rollover  
11 grant funds from the Grant toward the purchase of two mobile ATV  
12 rescue units. These mobile ATV rescue units will assist the  
13 Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department in providing enhanced and  
14 improved emergency medical services to the citizens of Duval County  
15 during local special events. The Grant allows interest earnings to  
16 be carried forward to the next grant cycle for this purpose. These  
17 funds will offset the higher than anticipated cost to procure the  
18 mobile rescue units.

19 **Section 3. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue  
20 Department, Rescue Division shall oversee the project described  
21 herein.

22 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
23 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
24 without the Mayor's signature.
