7 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE
8 MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION
9 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF
10 THE CITY AN AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR
11 2025-2026 CITY GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY
12 OF JACKSONVILLE AND I.M. SULZBACHER CENTER FOR
13 THE HOMELESS, INC. FOR THE MENTAL HEALTH
14 OFFENDER PROGRAM AS ORIGINALLY AUTHORIZED BY
15 ORDINANCE 2025-504-E, SUBJECT TO A REVISED
16 BUDGET AS DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR
17 CONTINUED OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACT
18 COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT;
19 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

21 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Ordinance 2025-504-E, the City Council
22 appropriated \$447,500 to I.M. Sulzbacher Center for the Homeless,
23 Inc. ("Sulzbacher") to support the Mental Health Offender Program
24 ("Program"); and

25 **WHEREAS**, Sulzbacher has requested certain adjustments to the
26 budget for the Program; and

27 **WHEREAS**, because this adjustment amounts to more than 10% of
28 the affected line-items, City Council approval of the change is
29 required; now therefore

30 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

31 **Section 1. Approval and Authorization to Execute.** There is

1 hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation
2 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of
3 the City an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 City Grant
4 Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and I.M. Sulzbacher Center
5 for the Homeless, Inc. for the Program, originally authorized by
6 Ordinance 2025-504-E, subject to the Budget Amendment Request Form
7 attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 1**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 1,
8 Rev Amded Budget, March 16, 2026 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein
9 by this reference, and all other contracts and documents, including
10 extensions, renewals and amendments to the agreement, and to otherwise
11 take all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance,
12 subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the General
13 Counsel, or his or her designee, and the City's Risk Management
14 Division for appropriate insurance and indemnification requirements
15 in accordance with Section 128.601, *Ordinance Code*.

16 The revised budget reflects a reallocation of funds from the
17 Compensation Psychiatrist line item to an Operating Expenses
18 Professional Fees line item and a consolidation of the Client Housing
19 (\$1,000) and Client Personal (\$1,100) line items to better support
20 the Program. There is no change to the overall budget amount.

21 **Section 2. Oversight.** The Grants and Contract Compliance
22 Division of the Finance Department shall oversee the project described
23 herein.

24 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
25 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
26 without the Mayor's signature.
