9 FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR FENTANYL ERADICATION
10 (S.A.F.E.) IN FLORIDA PROGRAM, TO THE PSBU
11 GRANTS/JACOB'S LADDER FY 23-24 PROJECT TO COMBAT
12 ILLEGAL FENTANYL ACTIVITY, AS INITIATED BY B.T.
13 24-090; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE
14 JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE; PROVIDING AN
15 EFFECTIVE DATE.

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17 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

18 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,
19 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
20 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
21 listed in subsection (b):

29 The funding above represents an appropriation of grant
30 funds from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement,
31 through its FY 23-24 State Financial Assistance for

1 Fentanyl Eradication (S.A.F.E.) in Florida Program, to the
2 Jacksonville Sheriff's Office PSBU Grants/Jacob's Ladder
3 FY 23-24 Project to combat illegal fentanyl activity. The
4 grant period commenced on July 1, 2023, and continues
5 through June 30, 2024. No local match is required.

6 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
7 Section 1 is to utilize the Fentanyl and Opioid Eradication (FOE)
8 grant funding from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement through
9 its FY 23-24 State Financial Assistance for Fentanyl Eradication
10 (S.A.F.E.) in Florida Program, to conduct investigations designed to
11 combat illegal fentanyl activity and will cover expenses related to
12 overtime for such investigations. A copy of the Financial Assistance
13 Agreement outlining the terms and conditions relative to the grant
14 and use of the grant funds is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and
15 incorporated herein by this reference.

16 **Section 3. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office
17 shall oversee administration of the grant and project described
18 herein.

19 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
20 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
21 without the Mayor's signature.
