(COLLECTIVELY, THE 22 "PROVIDERS"); APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, 23 OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY, AND/OR THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF KIDS HOPE 24 25 ALLIANCE, TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER CONTRACTS WITH THE PROVIDERS FOR THE PROVISION OF SERVICES TO IMPLEMENT 26 27 THE PROGRAM; WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 28 77.111(A) (PROVIDER CONTRACTS), CHAPTER 77 (KIDS 29 ALLIANCE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO EXEMPT HOPE THE 30 SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY THE PROVIDERS FROM 31 COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING

1 THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION 2 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER SEPARATE LICENSE 3 AGREEMENTS (OFFICE SPACE WITHIN BUILDING) BETWEEN 4 THE CITY AND CERTAIN PROVIDERS FOR THEIR USE AND 5 OCCUPANCY OF OFFICE SPACE WITHIN THE SOUTH WING OF 6 THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE BUILDING, LOCATED AT 1095 A. 7 PHILIP RANDOLPH BOULEVARD, BUILDING 1, JACKSONVILLE, 8 FLORIDA 32206, FOR A TERM, INCLUDING RENEWALS, OF 9 FOUR (4) YEARS TO EXPIRE ON JUNE 30, 2029, AND AT 10 NO COST TO PROVIDERS; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY 11 PASSAGE; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY KIDS HOPE 12 ALLIANCE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 13

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

25 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$5,750,000 in Social Impact Partnerships to Pay for Results Act ("SIPPRA") grant funds from the United State Department of the Treasury ("Treasury Department") to allow the Kids Hope Alliance ("KHA") to launch a suite of investments, including a universal nurse home visit for new parents and

a universal early literacy initiative through which health care providers coach parents on reading to their children "Program"). investments will (the These produce government savings through significant and value reductions in newborn emergency room visits and postpartum maternal depression. This is an outcome-based federal grant and the Treasury Department will release payments when outcomes are achieved. The grant period begins on December 6, 2024, and ends December 31, 2029, which may be extended if needed.

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11 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 12 Section 1 is to provide funding for the Program, and to procure the 13 professional services of Institute for Child Success, NLP Logix, LLC, 14 The Children's Home Society of Florida, Angel Kids Foundation, Inc., 15 Learning Partnership, Inc. (collectively, and Family the "Providers"). This award is subject to the terms and conditions 16 17 outlined in the United State Department of the Treasury Notice of 18 Award which has been placed **On File** with the Legislative Services 19 Division and is incorporated herein by this reference.

20 Section 3. Approval of Position. There is hereby approved 21 the position more fully described in R.C. 25-077, attached hereto as 22 Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. Said position 23 is fully funded by SIPPRA grant dollars and will provide services in 24 support of the Program.

25 Section 4. Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.108(g), 26 Ordinance Code. KHA is hereby authorized to procure professional services from Institute for Child Success, NLP Logix, LLC, 27 The 28 Children's Home Society of Florida, Angel Kids Foundation, Inc., and 29 Family Learning Partnership, Inc. Pursuant to Section 126.108(g) 30 (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement 31 Code), Ordinance Code, such services are exempted from competitive

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solicitation because the services to be provided are being approved via authorizing legislation pursuant to this Ordinance.

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3 Section 5. Approval and Authorization to Execute. The 4 Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary, and/or the 5 Chief Executive Officer of KHA, are hereby authorized to execute and 6 deliver contracts between KHA and Institute for Child Success, NLP 7 Logix, LLC, The Children's Home Society of Florida, Angel Kids 8 Foundation, Inc., and Family Learning Partnership, Inc., pursuant to 9 which the Providers will provide professional services necessary for 10 local implementation and administration of the Program in compliance with the grant described in Section 2. 11

12 Section 6. Waiver of the Requirements of Chapter 77 (Kids 13 Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), Ordinance 14 Code. The City hereby waives the requirements of Chapter 77 (Kids 15 Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), Ordinance Code, with respect to the contracts with Institute for Child Success, 16 17 NLP Logix, LLC, The Children's Home Society of Florida, Angel Kids 18 Foundation, Inc., and Family Learning Partnership, Inc. and 19 authorized in Section 5 of this Ordinance. Section 77.111(a) requires 20 contracts for children's services provided by third parties to be 21 competitively procured by KHA via an evaluated bid process. This 22 waiver is needed in order to allow KHA to directly contract with the 23 Providers to provide the Program services described in the grant 24 described in Section 2.

25 Section 7. License Agreements Approved and Execution 26 Authorized. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, 27 and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and 28 deliver, those certain License Agreements between the City and Angel 29 Kids Foundation, Inc., the City and The Children's Home Society of 30 Florida, and the City and Family Learning Partnership, Inc. in 31 substantially the forms attached hereto as Exhibits 3, 4, and 5, for

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the above-named Providers' use and occupancy of currently vacant office space located within the South Wing of the KHA Building located at 1095 A. Philip Randolph Boulevard, Jacksonville, Florida, for a term of one (1) year to expire on June 30, 2026, with three (3) one year renewal options such that if exercised the term may extend until June 30, 2029, at no cost to the Providers.

7 Section 8. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant 8 to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this 9 legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is this 10 legislation was originally filed with City Council in February 2025 11 but was withdrawn due to pending budget approvals from the Department 12 of Treasury. The budget has now been approved and KHA seeks a one-13 cycle passage of this bill to begin implementing the Grant as soon 14 as possible.

15 Section 9. Oversight Department. The Kids Hope Alliance 16 shall oversee administration of the SIPPRA grant, the Program and the 17 License Agreements.

18 Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 19 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 20 without the Mayor's signature.
