Type of Action: Ordinance amendment, one cycle emergency passage

Bill Summary: This bill amends Ordinance 2025-472-E to replace Revised Exhibit 2, the Northside Community Involvement, Inc. (NCI) Term Sheet and Budget. One cycle emergency passage is requested to ensure NCI is able to proceed with the Program, prior to the end of the calendar year or as soon thereafter as possible.

Background Information: Ordinance 2025-472-E appropriated \$125,000 from the Special Council Contingency account for NCI's Communities with Resources Working Together for the Betterment of Jacksonville, Florida Re-Grant Program. The program is designed to create opportunities for small businesses, including not-for-profits, after-school programs, and other agencies providing services to the community, by offering grants for development and enhancement of programs and services that engage and serve the community. The term sheet for that appropriation specified that all applicants for regrants through the Program must have a physical address within Council District 8. The revised term sheet in this legislation will allow for organizations located throughout Duval County the opportunity to apply for re-grants through the Program.
