Type of Action: Resolution encouraging JHA Board to delay selection of CEO

Bill Summary: This resolution encourages the Jacksonville Housing Authority (JHA) Board of Directors to delay the selection process for Chief Executive Officer of the Jacksonville Housing Authority for two months or until the Board has full membership. In addition, the bill strongly encourages the JHA Board to review the recommendations of the Inspector General's Report of Investigation; directs the Chief of Legislative Services to forward a copy of the resolution upon adoption to the Jacksonville Housing Authority Board; and requests emergency passage upon introduction.

Background Information: The Jacksonville Housing Authority Board is comprised of seven appointed members of which three seats are vacant. The Board is in the process of selecting a new CEO for Jacksonville Housing Authority. The resolution encourages the Board to delay the selection process until the Board reaches full membership. The Inspector General conducted an investigation and submitted a final report and recommendations on October 28, 2019. The Board is encouraged to review the Inspector General's Report of Investigation to begin implementing recommendations.
