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ORDINANCE 2024-875

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$100,000 FROM A DESIGNATED SPECIAL COUNCIL CONTINGENCY TO THE GENERAL FUND OPERATING, SUBSIDIES CONTRIBUTIONS TO PRIVATE ORG ACCOUNT, TO PROVIDE CITY GRANT FUNDING TO WEGOTCHU ENTERPRISES NPO, ("WEGOTCHU") FOR THE WEGOTCHU WELLNESS PROGRAM (THE "PROGRAM") AS DESCRIBED HEREIN; WAIVING SECTION 118.107 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH A COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH WEGOTCHU ENTERPRISES NPO, INC.; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY A GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND WEGOTCHU FOR THE PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation of \$100,000 from a Designated Special Council Contingency to the General Fund Operating, Subsidies and Contributions to Private Org account, to provide a grant to Wegotchu Enterprises NPO, Inc. ("Wegotchu") for the Wegotchu Salud Wellness Program (the "Program") as described herein.

The purpose of the appropriation in Section 2. Purpose. Section 1 is to provide grant funds from the City of Jacksonville to Wegotchu for the Wegotchu Salud Wellness Program as described in Exhibit 2, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. The Program was created to raise awareness regarding infectious dedicated diseases and to provide а community resource center/infectious disease clinic that focuses on treating infectious diseases. Wegotchu strives to provide medical education, intervention and prevention services for low-income Duval County residents living with or at risk of contracting an infectious disease, including by working with each patient to create a personalized wellness plan. The City funds will be used for various expenses to operate and administer the Program including paying a portion of the salaries for the Program Director, the Medical Director, a Registered Nurse, a Case Manager and a Community Engagement Supervisor, as well as costs for rent, medical software and various office supplies. In addition, a portion of the City funds will be used to purchase personal protective equipment for the medical professionals providing medical services and HIV/AIDS testing kits for the Program patients.

Section 3. Waiver of Section 118.107, Ordinance Code. The provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for a direct contract with Wegotchu. This waiver is justified because Wegotchu takes a unique approach to addressing a variety of issues that affect individuals with infectious diseases. More specifically, the Program provides medical services to underserved populations in Duval County while also offering a "90 Day Prep Program" or "PrEP" as a prevention strategy for people who are at higher risk of contracting HIV. PrEP participants receive workforce development assistance, financial education and income support and benefits exploration assistance.

Section 4. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City a grant agreement with Wegotchu Enterprises NPO, Inc. in an amount not-to-exceed \$100,000, subject to the Term Sheet and Budget more particularly described in Exhibit 2, for a term commencing on October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025, and all other contracts and documents, including extensions, renewals and amendments to the agreement, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the General Counsel, or his or her designee, and the City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance and indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601, Ordinance Code.

Section 5. Oversight Department. The Grants and Contract Compliance Division of the Finance Department shall oversee the project described herein.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become

effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
