A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF DARRIN EAKINS, A DUVAL COUNTY RESIDENT, AS A MEMBER OF THE CULTURAL SERVICE GRANT PROGRAM COMMITTEE, AS ONE OF THE THREE BOARD MEMBERS, REPLACING LISA V. JOHNSON, PURSUANT TO SECTION 118.605, ORDINANCE CODE, FOR A FIRST FULL TERM EXPIRING DECEMBER 31, 2027; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Confirmation of Appointment. The Council hereby confirms the appointment of Darrin Eakins, a Duval County resident, to the Cultural Service Grant Program Committee, replacing Lisa V.

Johnson, as one of the three board members, for a first full term expiring December 31, 2027.

Section 2. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is to ensure that the appointee is confirmed in a timely manner in order to attend the Cultural Service Grant Program Committee's orientation which is currently scheduled for Wednesday, June 4, 2025.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
