5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$200,000.00 FROM
6 THE PETCO FOUNDATION TO ASSIST CITY'S DIVISION
7 OF ANIMAL CARE AND PROTECTIVE SERVICES IN
8 INCREASING COMMUNITY AWARENESS AND THE
9 ADOPTION RATE AT THE SHELTER, AS INITIATED BY
10 B.T. 19-096; PROVIDING FOR A CARRYOVER OF
11 FUNDS TO FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020; APPROVING AND
12 AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CORPORATION
13 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THE PETCO
14 FOUNDATION GRANT INVESTMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN
15 THE CITY AND THE PETCO FOUNDATION; AMENDING
16 ORDINANCE 2018-504-E (THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE
17 BUDGET ORDINANCE) BY AMENDING ATTACHMENT A
18 ("FOOD AND BEVERAGE EXPENDITURES") IN ORDER TO
19 ALLOW FUNDS TO BE SPENT ON FOOD AND BEVERAGE
20 AT SHELTER EVENTS; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY
21 THE ANIMAL CARE AND PROTECTIVE SERVICES
22 DIVISION OF THE NEIGHBORHOODS DEPARTMENT;
23 PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

25 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

26 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2018-2019 fiscal year,
27 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
28 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
29 the accounts listed in subsection (b):

31 by this reference):

5 (c) Explanation of appropriation:

6 The funding above is a grant award from The Petco
7 Foundation to assist City's Division of Animal Care and
8 Protective Services in increasing community awareness and
9 the adoption rate at the shelter. The grant does not
10 require a City match and the grant end date is January
11 31, 2021.

12 **Section 2. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in Section 1
13 of this ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover into fiscal
14 year 2019-2020.

15 **Section 3. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
16 Section 1 is to provide additional funds for shelter marketing
17 campaigns, training seminars, volunteer appreciation events, event
18 promotion, and fees associated with events.

19 **Section 4. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby
20 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary
21 are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, The Petco Foundation
22 Grant Investment Agreement between the City and The Petco
23 Foundation, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and
24 incorporated herein by this reference.

25 **Section 5. Amending Ordinance 2018-504-E by amending**
26 **Attachment A ("Food and Beverage Expenditures").** Ordinance 2018-
27 504-E is amended by amending Attachment A thereto ("Food and
28 Beverage Expenditures") by substituting a new Fourth Revised
29 Attachment A, attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**, incorporated herein by
30 this reference, and made a part of Ordinance 2018-504-E, in order
31 to allow funds to be spent on food and beverages at shelter events.

1 **Section 6. Oversight.** The Animal Care and Protective
2 Services Division of the Neighborhoods Department shall oversee the
3 project described herein.

4 **Section 7. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
5 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
6 without the Mayor's signature.
